

PARTNERSHIP WITH EMPLOYERS

Faculty of Public Health, Universitas Indonesia is one of the prestigious Public Health Faculties in Indonesia. It was founded on July 1965. The objectives of the formation of the Faculty of Public Health at that time were to produce health workers who were trained in the field of public health for health services, to produce health workers who are trained in the field of public health for tertiary institutions, and to provide expertise education in the field of public health for college graduates such as doctors, dentists, veterinarians, pharmacists, engineers, and to provide further education for medical personnel who have passed the academy level such as health inspectors academies, nutrition academies, and nurse academies.

As one of the prestigious and the oldest Faculty of Public Health in Indonesia, Faculty of Public Health, Universitas Indonesia receives a lot of partnership offerings from state-owned enterprises, private sector companies, and even from the non-governmental organization both from Indonesia and abroad. The forms of partnership offerings received by the Faculty of Public Health, Universitas Indonesia include internships and job opportunities for its students. A. INTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

1. State-Owned Enterprises (Badan Usaha Milik Negara)

State-owned enterprises (Badan Usaha Milik Negara) are companies that are wholly, largely, or partly owned by the Indonesian government and the government exerts control over them. In Indonesia, the state-owned enterprises are divided into 14 sectors namely accommodation and provision of food and beverages, processing industry, information and telecommunications, financial and insurance services, professional, scientific, and technical services, construction, water supply, waste management, and recycling, provision of electricity, wholesale and retail trade, mining and excavation, agriculture, forestry, and fisheries, real estate, transportation and warehousing, and joint venture or minority.

Students from Faculty of Public Health, Universitas Indonesia who receives partnership offerings in the form of internship opportunities from state-owned enterprises are usually major in Environmental Health and/or Occupational Health and Safety. During the internship, students learned about safety culture at workplaces,

potential hazards and risks, how to manage hazards and risks, and environmental issues such as waste management system, vector-borne diseases, and food safety. The following Table 1 is the complete list of students who receives internship opportunities from state-owned enterprises:

2. Regional-Owned Enterprises (Badan Usaha Milik Daerah)

Regional-owned enterprises (Badan Usaha Milik Daerah) are companies that are wholly, largely, or partly owned by the regional government which is the Government of DKI Jakarta Province. The Government of DKI Jakarta Province currently owned several companies that engaged in the property, construction, entertainment, provision of food and beverages, marketplace, provision of poultry products, financial and insurance services, water supply, waste management, and transportation field.

Students from Faculty of Public Health, Universitas Indonesia who receives partnership offerings in the form of internship opportunities from regional-owned enterprises are usually major in Environmental Health and/or Occupational Health and Safety. During the internship, students learned about safety culture at workplaces, potential hazards and risks, how to manage hazards and risks, and environmental issues such as waste management system, vector-borne diseases, and food safety. There are more than 3,000 private sector companies in Indonesia as of 2021 who are engaged in a variety of different fields. 4. Health Institutions

In Indonesia, the health service center is divided into three levels: primary health care center, secondary health care center, and tertiary health care center. Primary health care center is where the first contact occurs between patients and health care personnel as the initial process of health care. It is also where most students from the Faculty of Public Health can apply their knowledge and learn new things.

Students who receives internship opportunities here are usually from Public Health, Nutrition, or Environmental Health major. They will get the chance to participate in providing health promotion materials, checking for vector-borne diseases in households, conduct health surveillance, and giving out basic medical examination like checking blood pressure and body weight during the internship.

5. Schools

In Indonesia, the education system is divided as compulsory study period and additional study period. The compulsory study period consists of six years of primary school, three years of secondary school, and three years of high school. While the additional study period consists of higher education to obtain bachelor, master, or doctorate's degree. Usually, students from the Faculty of Public Health focuses to give health intervention to students who's attending the compulsory study period because it is the golden age for them to learn and understand more about health.

6. Non-Governmental Organization

A non-governmental organization (NGO) is a non-profit group that functions independently of any government. NGOs, sometimes called civil societies, are organized on community, national and international levels to serve as a social or political goal such as humanitarian causes or the environment. In Indonesia, there are almost 3,000 NGOs according to The SMERU Research Institute Database. Students from the Faculty of Public Health are also given the opportunities to serve as an intern in some of the national level NGO in Indonesia.

Usually, the students will join in the humanitarian-driven NGOs that provides support for people with HIV/AIDS, the shemale community, or safe houses for children and elderly people. They will get the chance to participate in providing health promotion materials and giving out basic medical examination like checking blood pressure and body weight during the internship. Students who major in Public Health and minor in Health Promotion and Behavioral Science are usually the one who receives this opportunity.
